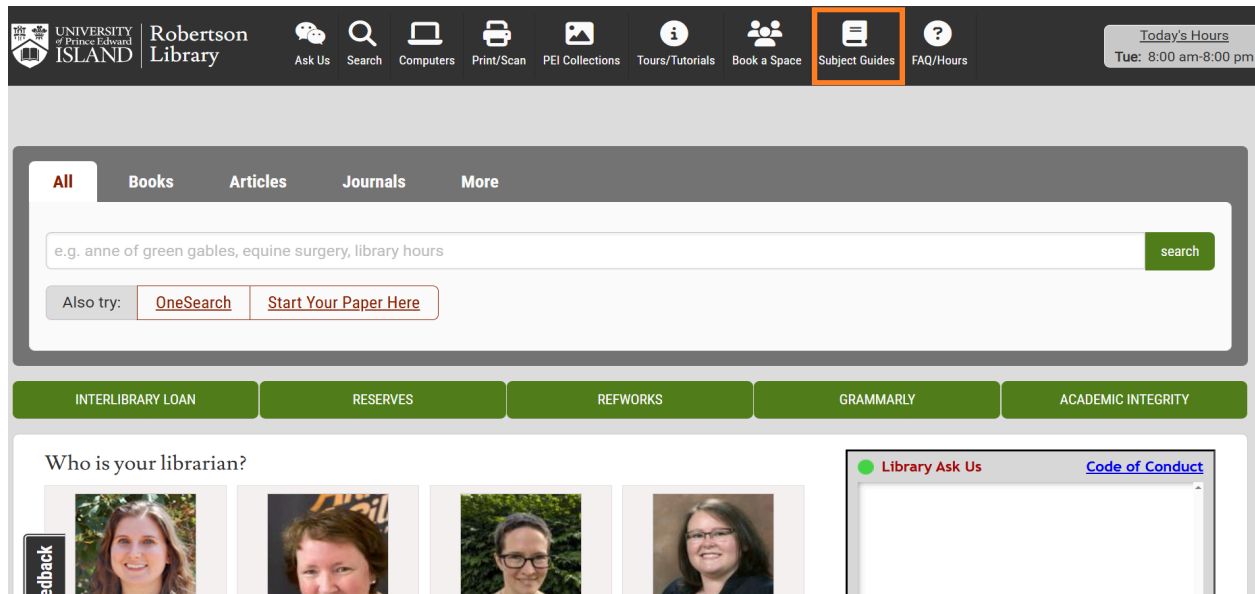

Liaison (Subject) Librarians

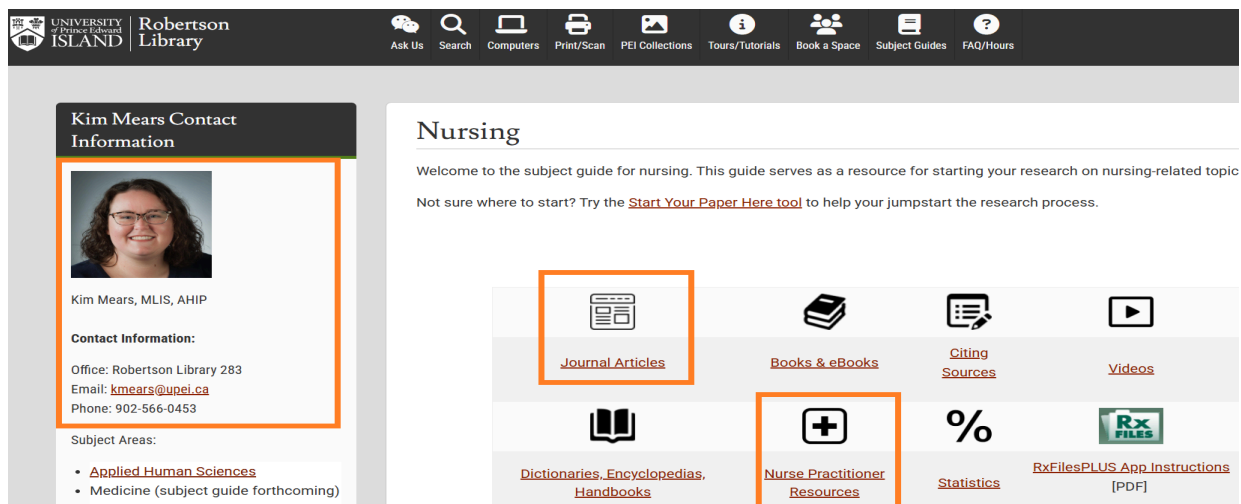
Liaison Librarians specialize in the subjects listed. If you need advanced research assistance in a specific discipline, contact the Librarian (users) are area code 902.
